SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING GUIDELINES - UPDATED NOVEMBER 25, 2019

1. Know what to throw. 2. Empty. Clean. Dry. 3. Don't Bag it.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

PLASTICS

- All Plastic Containers Labeled #1 - #7



Remove caps/lids, rinse. Labels and neck rings do not need to be removed.

METAL

- Aluminum beverage cans
- Steel food and beverage cans & empty aerosol cans

Remove caps/lids, rinse. Labels do not need to be removed.

GLASS

- Clear, brown, & green glass food and beverage containers

CARDBOARD, PAPERBOARD, PAPER

- All sizes of cardboard boxes
- Empty paper towel & toilet paper rolls
- Food boxes (ie. crackers, cereal, cake boxes)
- Magazines, Catalogs, Envelopes
- Newspapers, Inserts and Junk Mail
- Office and School paper (any color)
- Paper bags (grocery type)
- Paperboard packaging (ie. tissue boxes)
- Phone books & other soft cover books

Be sure all inside packaging is removed.

(ie. Styrofoam, bubble wrap, peanuts, plastic liners, plastics, etc.)

No need to remove staples, tape or labels from boxes.

Keep paper and cardboard items dry.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Aluminum and Tin Foil
- Broken Glass
- Drinking Glasses
- Electronics or Batteries
- Food-Soiled Materials
- Light Bulbs
- Needles (contact with hypodermic needles can cause serious injury)
- Pizza boxes
- Plastic Bags (Including Grocery Bags)
- Plastic Tableware (Knives, Forks, etc.)
- Plastic Toys or Sporting Goods
- Polystyrene Cups or Plates
- Scrap Metal
- Soaked and/or Wet Papers or Cardboard
- Solvents, Oil and/or Chemical Containers
- Styrofoam
- Tupperware or Disposable Plastic Containers
- Waxy Cardboard
- Windows, Mirrors, Ceramics
